General Guidelines

- stART on the Street is a one day outdoor festival on a paved street surface taking place on Park Avenue in Worcester, MA
- Arrival information will be emailed the first week in September
- Non-Profit spaces are allotted as non-profits register the morning of the event. Requests for pre-assigned spaces are not accepted
- All non-profit organizations will be located on the sidewalk of Park Avenue along Elm Park (from Elm Street to Highland Street)
- You may hand out brochures, products and collect cash donations but are not allowed to sell any products unless permission has been given by festival organizers. If so desired, only individually wrapped food or candy items may be given away; no beverage or open food giveaways please
- Spaces are approximately 6' wide but if you require additional space please contact us to arrange this. NOTHING is included with your space so please plan accordingly. A 6' table and 2 chairs can be rented for \$20 - make the appropriate selection on your application
- Electricity is not available
- Tents require pre-approval* and must be properly weighed down with at least 20lbs of weight per tent leg. Umbrellas are allowed
- Non-Profits must commit to the Sept 19th date as well as the Sept 26th rain date
- You are required to staff your space during the entire festival, 11am-5pm
- Event organizers reserve the right to reject any applicant at their discretion
- Refunds for cancellations will not be issued after August 27, 2010. No exceptions
- The theme for the 2010 Festival is "What does art mean to you?", featuring multiple demonstrations of all kinds of creative process throughout the festival. We invite you to incorporate this theme if at all possible.
